Tanya Goel's works which we have come to adore are large-scale indulgences on colour and its infinite permutations through the abstract format. Her art has a lot of mobility within its grid-like layers. It relies on capturing intersections of disarray and conflict within the structured mesh and framework of the urban landscapes. Colour, line, texture intertwine to extract her observations of the architecture and urbanity which she experiences while shuttling between New York, Delhi and Mumbai. From industrial tarpaulin that provides roofs to many houses to the monochromatic boxes that the masses live in, Tanya's work becomes a raw impersonation of the city and its conflicted lattice.
